The Intern Manual

Hello.

Thank you for supporting Magpie Pedals and getting yourself one of my effects pedals! Please feel free to use it with guitar, bass, synths, vocals, or anything in between. (Results may vary).

The pedal uses 9VDC + on a center negative power jack (2.1mm).

Controls:

Footswitch: Effect Bypass.

Knob: The Intern has two different signal chains that you mix between with the big knob. All the way counterclockwise is a rather sharp fuzz/distortion and all the way clockwise is a monophonic octave down synth voice.

Mixing between these two signals to find your own personal sweet spot makes for some magical glitchy gnarly 8-bit sounding madness.

<u>Trimpot</u>: On the inside you will find a trimpot. This trimpot sets the volume for when the pedal is turned on. Tweak this if you find the pedal either to loud or if you wish it to be EVEN LOUDER.
